APR, the Association of Plastic Recyclers, is pleased to recognize Pactiv Evergreen Inc.'s expanded polypropylene hinged lid containers as meeting or exceeding the most strict APR Critical Guidance Protocol for PP Rigid Containers criteria, PP-CG-01, and hereby so states. The undecorated, hinged containers exhibit a foamed density of about 0.1-0.5 grams/cm³ with a non-Freon blowing gas.

A Review Committee, appointed per the APR Recognition Operating Procedures, reviewed your January 14, 2021 data submission and concluded the data were correctly obtained by a qualified laboratory and were completely presented to show the foamed PP lidded container submitted meets or exceeds the most challenging test conditions and strictest APR Critical Guidance criteria.

This APR Recognition applies to the containers for which data were submitted. The PP Critical Guidance document that was used to evaluate the Pactiv Evergreen containers is the product of a multi-industry consensus process to identify and address certain key technical considerations related to the recycling of postconsumer polypropylene packaging. The Document directs innovators to conduct specific testing per established testing procedures and then provides the innovator with guidance to interpret the results. The protocols are intended to help improve the quality of the recycled container stream by aiding innovators to make informed decisions about the consequences of packaging innovations. APR thanks Pactiv Evergreen Inc. for voluntarily submitting its containers for Recognition. The impact of these protocols is beneficial to world-wide recycling efforts. Meeting the Critical Guidance protocol is truly significant steps in demonstrating overall recyclability of your containers.

Our recognition applies only to the hinged lid containers. Any decorations were not tested and are not included. Meeting the Critical Guidance Document guidelines is a truly significant step in demonstrating overall recyclability of your container product.
